Initially wickets were scarce but Joe Reid made the initial breakthrough. After having made one change of bowling the opposition had reached 139 for 1 off 26 overs; at this point the spinners were brought on and proved that wisdom was a good substitute for youth as Bill Kincaid and Rowan McGregor stemmed the run rate and began to take wickets. RMAS eventually declared at 217 for 6 off 42 overs.

On paper SoA had a strong batting line up, however the RMAS bowlers got the upper hand and soon had SoA 56 for 7 off 20 overs; this did not include the wicket of Gary McDade, who as a member of staff at RMAS and on his debut for SoA, got a ball that came off the top edge of his bat and into his chin, forcing him to retire hurt for stitches (the cadet who caused this injury will remain nameless, but needless to say he will not end up in the same Regt as Gary!). The seventh wicket fell just before 1800hrs, which left SoA to face 21 overs with one wicket in hand; by a stroke of luck and some cool headedness from Rowan McGregor they managed this and forced the draw.
